

COOKIES POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

- (a) This document sets out the Cookies Policy of Shingleback Off Road Pty Ltd ACN 633 831 393.
- (b) In this Cookies Policy, Shingleback Off Road Pty Ltd is referred to as we, us or our.
- (c) This Cookies Policy applies when you use the website operated by us, available at www.shinglebackoffroad.com.au and any related pages or subdomains we operate from time to time (**Website**).
- (d) This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, the types of cookies and similar technologies we may use, how we use them, and how you can control them.
- (e) We may update this Cookies Policy from time to time by posting an updated copy on our website. We encourage you to check our website regularly to ensure that you are aware of our current Cookies Policy.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

- (a) A cookies is a small file that is stored on your computer, mobile phone or other device when you visit a website that uses cookies.
- (b) We may use cookies and similar technologies on our Website for website functionality, performance, analytics, advertising, security and content purposes.
- (c) Cookies help us operate the Website, improve your browsing experience, understand how visitors use the Website, remember certain preferences, identify issues with the Website, and assess whether our marketing is effective and relevant.
- (d) The types of cookies we may use on the Website are set out below.

Strictly necessary cookies	These cookies are essential for the proper functioning of our Website. Without them, the Website may not work properly or certain features may not be available. For example, these cookies may remember information you have entered from one page to the next during a single browsing session.
Performance cookies	These cookies collect information about how you use the Website, including the pages you visit and how often you visit them. We use this information to identify usage patterns, collect analytics data, identify issues with the Website, improve the browsing experience, and assess whether our marketing is effective and relevant.
Functional cookies	These cookies improve your experience on the Website by remembering certain preferences or settings, such as region, display preferences or other details that make the Website more convenient to use. Functional cookies may also include security cookies and load balancing cookies that help support website security, speed and performance.
Advertising cookies	These cookies may be used to provide advertising or marketing content that is more relevant to your interests. They may remember that you visited the Website and may share that information with third party advertising or marketing providers.
Content cookies	These cookies may be placed by third party tools or plugins used on the Website, such as embedded videos, social media features or other content tools. These third party services may also use cookies for analytics, advertising or market analysis purposes.

3. HOW LONG WILL COOKIES REMAIN ON MY DEVICE?

- (a) The amount of time that a cookies remains on your computer, mobile phone or other device depends on the type of cookies used.
- (f) Session cookies remain on your device only while you are browsing and are usually deleted when you close your browser.
- (g) Persistent cookies remain on your device until they expire or are deleted. Depending on the cookie, this may be for a short period or for a longer period.
- (h) You can delete cookies from your device or manage cookies settings through your browser.

4. HOW DO THIRD PARTIES USE COOKIES ON THE WEBSITE?

- (a) We may use third party cookies, analytics tools and similar technologies on the Website.
- (b) These third parties may collect information about how you use the Website, including pages visited, time spent on the Website, device information, browser information, approximate location information and interactions with Website content.
- (c) We use Google Analytics and may use other standard analytics providers from time to time to help us understand Website traffic, improve the Website, identify issues and assess the effectiveness of our marketing.
- (d) Third party providers may use cookies and similar technologies in accordance with their own privacy policies and cookies policies.
- (e) You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings. You may also be able to adjust your preferences directly through some third party tools or platforms.

5. HOW DO I CONTROL COOKIES?

- (a) You can usually control and manage cookies through your browser settings.
- (f) Your browser may allow you to accept cookies, refuse cookies, delete cookies, receive alerts before cookies are stored, or manage cookies for particular websites.
- (g) If you remove or block cookies, this may affect your experience of the Website and some parts of the Website may not work properly.
- (h) Some third party advertising, analytics or social media services may also allow you to control tracking or advertising preferences directly through their own platforms or opt-out tools.
- (i) We do not currently provide a separate cookies preference tool on the Website.
